Nearly every town had a fuel shop in times gone by. Our (rather small) model includes fuels of every type. The sack scales are used to weigh deliveries

The sack scales are used to weigh deliveries for customers before loading. A movable wall-mounted crane for heavier goods is located on the storage shed. A timber-clad office extension is built onto the brick timber-frame building.

The kit includes tools, including shovels, brooms and wheelbarrows, as well as briquette stacks and pallets to complete your design.


11 466 H0 Coal-loading yard

The coal-loading yard is the perfect complement to the fuel shop. Loose briquettes (Brand Jowela) are stored in the two coal hoppers awaiting transfer to the delivery vehicle by gravity and conveyor belt.

A ladder for maintenance work and slider rods for operating the unloading hatches are intricately laser-cut from cardboard. The set is rounded off by a weighbridge with its weighing mechanism protected from the weather in a shelter.

11 468 H0 Cable shunting device



Cable shunting devices are used to move wagons on loading sidings, in factory yards, under loading installations and the like. In times gone by, shunting by means of a cable drawn by a winch was a common alternative in situations where a shunting locomotive could not be used.

Our replica operates with four moving, intricately designed pulleys and the included cable. The realistic winch house with interior fittings covers the enclosed drive motor in the model.

41 675 H0 Loader T172, Coal claw

Kit. The T172 was built in 1961–67. A further development of the T170, it came with a 17 hp motor, two-speed gearbox, a new hydraulically operated boom constructed of sheet metal and dual tyres on the rear axle.

The detailed, intricately designed kit is a reproduction with blue/grey paintwork that matches our fuel shop theme. The front axle can be steered, the model rotated by 360° and the boom tilted.


Designed true to the original, this can be extended with an intermediate section and fitted with a hook, rake grapple or clamshell bucket. With the longer boom, it can be used to feed the hopper silos in the coal-loading yard No. 11 466.

Single tyres for the drive axle are included for loading on a flat-bed car. A detailed tow bar and warning stripes on the crane's structure are printed on the model.

41 676 H0 Multicar M22 high-board tipper with tipper trailer

Kit. The M22 multicar vehicle series is being expanded to include a further variant. This model is a blue/grey high-board tipper that matches our fuel shop line.

The box can be tipped up with an open rear panel. Its matching tipper trailer is a replica of a model produced by Fahrzeugbau Lampe in Möser near Magdeburg.

The box can be tilted and the front axle steered.



41 674 H0 Loader T170

Kit. The self-propelled Loader T170 was produced in the GDR from the mid-1950s and was used on farms and building sites. Powered by its own drive, it could 'speed' along at just 3.5 km/h, but could be towed at up to 20 km/h. The 6.3-m-long boom consisting of two tubes was raised and lowered by cables. With a 10 hp engine, later upgraded to 13 hp, it could lift up to 0.8 t. Our intricate kit is an exact replica of the real-life vehicle. The model can be rotated through 360° on a chassis equipped with a steerable front axle. The boom, which can be tilted to different angles, can be fitted with a hook, rake grapple or clamshell bucket. Black/yellow warning stripes are printed on the back of the blue structure. 41 673 H0 Crawler crane RK3


Kit. The electrically driven RK3 crawler crane, also known as the "Bleichert crane", was built in Leipzig. A few are still in operation today and are used for coaling steam locomotives and for loading work.

The model can be fitted with a hook or grabber. A rotatable yellow crane is supported by the grey chassis with intricate rust-brown chains.

Detailed printing with warning stripes and the "TAKRAF" logo on the driver's door put the finishing touch on the model.



13 349 TT Bus station



Cities often have bus stations as central transport interchanges. Many terminals were built in Eastern and Western Germany in the 1960s and 1970s due to the rapid increase in bus transport. The model features a modern design, making it a good fit for contemporary model-railway lines as well.

This kit can be used to build three platforms: two for buses and one for taxis. A modern glass roof structure protects the platforms from the rain.

Two small buildings serve as a ticket office with toilets as well as a snack bar. Waste bins, benches, signs and two telephone booths are included for completing your layout. The taxi rank features a pillar-type call box from the GDR period.

43 678 TT Multicar M24 High-board tipper

Kit. The M24 multicar, like its predecessor the M22, was built with a single cabin in its first variant in 1974–77.

The model is designed as a high-board tipper. Higher side walls allow the transport of larger quantities of relatively lightweight bulk goods, such as potatoes, coal, wood and the like. When assembled, the box can be tipped up with an open rear panel.

This especially detailed model is made even more authentic by the printed round headlights and manufacturer's logo.




A conveyor belt is used to fill the hoppers and to load vehicles, which are weighed on the weighbridge before and after loading.

The weighing mechanism is located in a corrugated sheet metal shelter, where it is protected from the weather.
